Pandemic Version: *During the Pandemic we have modified the birthday policy.

We will cheer our birthday girl/boy up while welcoming him/her from the carpool and you are welcome to bring individually packed goodie bags or cupcakes or another peanut-free treat to share with the classmates. Everything needs to be individually packed and we make sure to disinfect them once again before handing them to the kids.Please remember that we can not have any balloons, icing, food coloring or candles in the school.

Non-Pandemic Version:

At Da Vinci International School, birthdays are a great opportunity to celebrate our students. Parents/guardians may coordinate with their teacher to find a good day and time to celebrate in their classroom.

SPECIAL BIRTHDAY TREATS

Sending or Bringing Food Items: Parents/guardians are welcome to distribute "treats" in celebration of their student's birthday, provided they do not contain, either explicitly or potentially, any ingredients that violate the DVIS Peanut-Free Policy (detailed in this handbook) or ingredients to which any student in the class has reported allergies. See your teacher for classroom allergies.

Store-Bought Food Items: Leave in original labeled containers for ingredient verification by the teacher prior to student consumption.

Homemade Food Items: Submit a signed document listing the ingredients used.

ITEMS NOT PERMITTED (under any circumstances)

- NO Icing
- NO Food Coloring on/in cakes, pastries, icing, or other items
- NO Candy (sugar free OK)
- NO Items that could be considered a choking hazard (in treat bags especially)
- NO Candles (with open flames LED fine)
- NO Decorations
- NO Flowers
- NO Balloons (latex or foil)

When celebrating faculty/staff birthdays with your class, please adhere to the same rules.
